



Frequently Asked Questions

I'm a champion, so what's next?

Your site liaison will set up a meeting with you and your co-champion to plan your timeline, schedule regular check ins and set expectations to receive your scholarships.

Who evaluates my work?

Your designated site liaison evaluates your work.

Can my friends be involved with some of the assignments?

Yes, talk with your site liaison and fellow champion to coordinate efforts. The more students and faculty involved the better.

What if one of the required projects can't be completed?

Yes. For example, the photo essay can be incorporated into the Yearbook Story or social media posts can be shared on the website. Consulting with your site liaison will make modifications easy.

When is the deadline for finishing assignments?

We've created a suggested timeline for you and your co-champion, which can be flexible with scheduling. Teamwork is important so coordinate with your site liaison to leverage your time to reach your goals. Know that you have a lot of support to meet your obligations, so keep channels of communication open and encourage students to be invested in their success.

When do I receive my scholarship award?

Financial scholarships will be awarded by your school and funds distributed to the post secondary education program of your choice.
